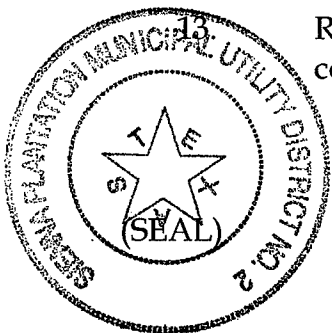



NOTICE OF MEETING

The Board of Directors of Sienna Plantation Municipal Utility District No. 2 will hold a regular meeting on Monday, April 20, 2009, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of SWWC Services Inc., 12535 Reed Road, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Receive public comments.
3. Approve Second Amended Restated Drought Contingency Plan.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
5. Review Arbitrage Rebate Study for Series 1998 Bonds.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
7. Report from Texas Services, Ltd. regarding ditch maintenance program.
8. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. Capital Project Report.
 - b. Authorize advertisement and adopt new engineering proposal for construction of Primary Collector Ditch and Unmaintainable Cul-de-Sac Piping Project.
 - c. Approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate, for construction of water, sewer and drainage facilities for the following projects:
 - i. Steep Bank Village Ditch Project, Phase III (Special Projects Account).
 - d. Klotz' request for additional services and payment for related fees.
 - e. Final payment with Phase II of Steep Bank Village Ditch Project.
 - f. Approve Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Requesting Use of Surplus Funds.
9. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance.
10. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers, and authorize termination of service.
11. Master District Matters.
12. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, including permit protests.
